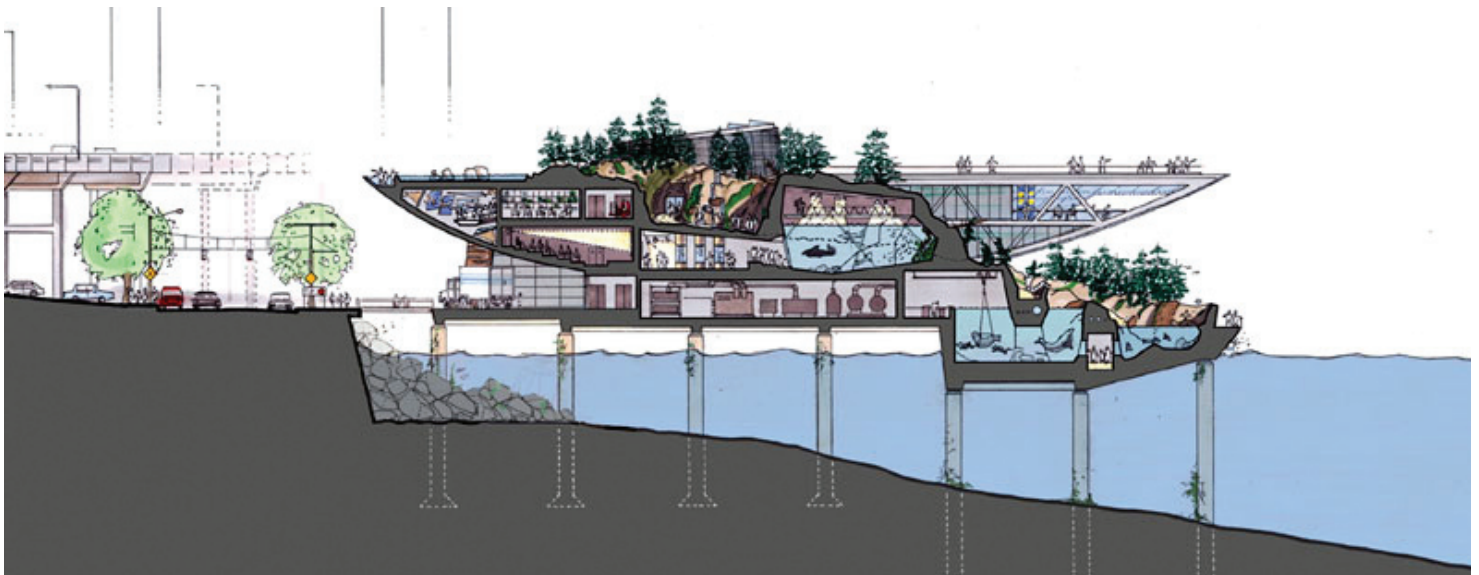

Working in a highly collaborative fashion with the London-based architectural firm of Terry Farrell & Partners and the Seattle-based firm of Mithun Partners, the project is a true reflection of design from the “inside – out” whereby the animal requirements, the exhibit storyline, and the overall visitor experience have served as the basis for the aquarium’s architectural expression.
