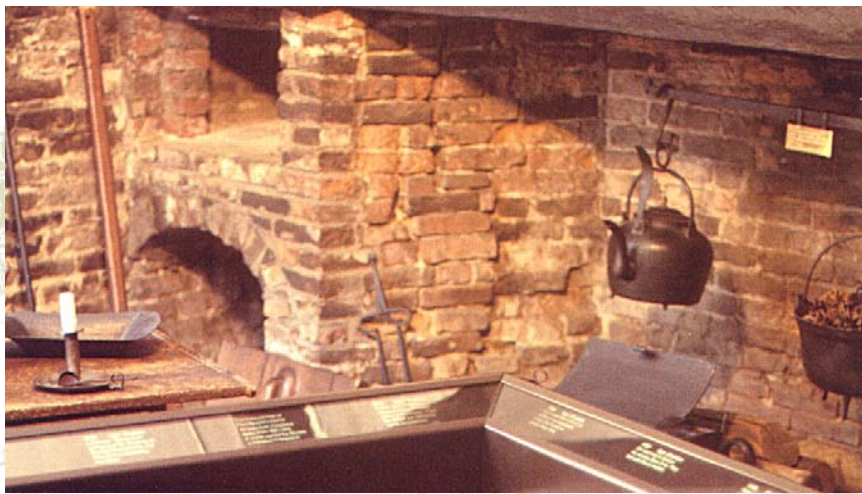

Prior to forming Lyons/Zaremba Inc., Richard Lyons and Charles Beier were hired to prepare Boston's famed Paul Revere House for the National Bicentennial Celebration. The challenge: to enable huge crowds to visit the house, while maintaining high quality experiences for visitors and protecting the collections.

The solution: a temporary rear-lit graphic handrail system that directed visitors in a one-way traffic flow. The handrail limited full access to rooms, yet provided visitors with a personal and highly entertaining history of Paul Revere and his family.
